Alta Scuola Politecnica (ASP) is a school for young and exceptionally talented students, with a passion for innovation, who wish to develop their potential in a multidisciplinary community.

ASP selects 150 students per year, among the applicants to the Master of Science programs -- MSc (Laurea Magistrale) in Engineering, Architecture and Design at Politecnico di Milano (PoliMi) and Politecnico di Torino (PoliTo).

The ASP program runs parallel to the MSc programs of the two institutions. The official ASP language is English.

ASP offers courses, dedicated to develop interdisciplinary expertise and links between the students' different disciplinary backgrounds, and multidisciplinary projects, developed in close collaboration among small teams of students, academic tutors, and companies or public institutions. Students are selected for the ASP program from the top 5% of the BSc classes, obtaining financial support and, when needed, free on-campus accommodation; students who successfully complete the ASP program receive the ASP diploma and the double MSc Degree from both PoliMi and PoliTo.
